

OIC network drive for data transfer

The computers of all microscopes maintained by the OIC have a connection to a network drive for transferring your data. You can retrieve this data from your own computer. Each microscope has a corresponding folder into which the data is saved.

To connect to the network drive, please use the following address and credentials:

<\\OIC-STATION.erasmusmc.nl/OIC>

User name = .\guest (Don't forget the .\)



Password = guest

For Windows10

- To link the network drive, open the Windows File Explorer and go to *this PC* and open the tab *Computer*.
- Use *Map network drive*.
- Select a drive letter and enter the address from above
- Activate *Reconnect at sign-in* & *Connect using different credentials*.
- When asked for credentials choose *more choices*, and choose *Use a different account*.
- Enter credentials from above and *activate: remember my credentials*.

For Mac

- Select *Go* in the Finder and *pull down* the menu.
- Choose *Connect to Server*.
- Fill in: `afp://OIC-STATION.erasmusmc.nl`.
- Log in with username: `guest` and password: `guest`
- The server should show up on your desktop.



--- Reminder ---

- **You are responsible for backing up your data!**
- The microscope computers should not be used for data storage.
 - Only a small amount of data (<100MB) is allowed for reuse purposes.
- Data on the network drive older than 1 month will be deleted automatically.
